Skills: Aiming High and Creativity

Head to your local library and find a non-fiction book that interests you – it could be about :

- history
- nature
- science
- design



Pick something that sparks your interest and makes you want to learn more.

Take notes while you read your non-fiction book.

Then, use your imagination to make the information into an exciting comic book story (that still has all the correct facts!)

or

Find out about one sports person who inspires you.

This could be a professional athlete, a local sporting hero, a friend or family member or your sports coach. Anyone who loves sport and inspires you! Make a fact file on this person. Find out about their sporting life, what inspires them to play their sport, how they got into their sport in the first place, and what they did to get where they are today. Why not send them a letter to tell them why they inspire you?

Be a Historian

Ages 5 - 16

Category: History & Heritage

Skills: Aiming High and Creativity

Visit a museum, castle, or any place that has an interesting past

Write about what you found interesting.

You could find some books in the library that tell you more about the people or things you learned about.

OR

Make a model of the building, object or make a costume.

OR

Draw a picture of what it may have looked like in the past.
