

Make a special Kindness Advent Jar for all the family to try

- **Choose a Jar or Container:** Find a jar, box, or any container you like. You can decorate it to make it more personal and visually appealing.
- **Write Down Acts of Kindness:** On small slips of paper, write down various kindness acts. Involve all the family for suggestions. Make Christmas tree & star shapes out of card and glue the acts of kindness on to them
- **Fill the Jar:** Place all the slips of kindness acts in the jar and mix them up.
- **Draw one slip each day.** Take turns to choose and complete the kindness activity
- **When each activity has been completed add a string to the card and put onto the Christmas tree or peg to a string along the wall to celebrate your success.**

Suggestions for kindness challenges

Make a Christmas Card for someone who you think may be lonely, to let them know you are thinking of them

Donate some food to your local food bank

If you have toys that you no longer play with, donate them to your local charity shop

Make a thank you card for someone special

Paint some rocks with messages of kindness and leave them around for people to find

Open the door for someone.....
