
Hobbycraft Workshops for kids

EASTER STEM CHALLENGES

Science Sparks EASTER STEM CHALLENGES EGGY ZIP WIRE

Can you build a harness to transport an egg down a zip wire? This is a great activity for learning about friction. Try changing the type of string used to see what types of string make your egg travel faster.

EGGY TOWERS

Use toothpicks or straws to build a tower strong enough to support the weight of an egg.

Plasticine, jelly sweets or even marshmallows are great for sticking everything together!







DOWN THE EGG CHUTE

Find a large tube big enough to drop an egg down.

Investigate to find the best material to wrap the egg in to stop it breaking as it hits the ground.

Another idea is to build a landing pad at he bottom of the tube to break the fall of the egg!



Find out how many eggs weigh the same as a chocolate egg?

Which is the heaviest? A real egg or chocolate egg?







EGG SAILING

Build a boat from recycled materials such as foil, cardboard boxes, egg cartons or a plastic container.

Check the boat floats and test to see how many eggs it can hold without

sinking
